

INCOSE UK Professional Registration 5 Year licence Renewal

INCOSE UK is delighted to announce that on 30th January 2025, the Engineering Council awarded INCOSE UK a 5-year extension of their Professional Registration Licence.

INCOSE UK has been on a 14-year journey to become a fully licensed Professional Engineering Institute. Initially a Professional Affiliate with an agreement to offer professional registration, first with the IET and latterly with the Society of Environmental Engineers (SEE), since February 2020, INCOSE UK has been approved as a Licensed Professional Engineering Institution (PEI) of the Engineering Council as part of the Joint Registration Board (JRB) with the Institute of Explosive Engineers.

To date we have registered (including transfers) 86 INCOSE UK members with the Engineering Council on the national Register of professional engineers and technicians.

Professional Development Director of INCOSE UK, Steven Turner states, “I'm really pleased we've been awarded this licence extension. It shows a real confidence in INCOSE UK and the JRB by the Engineering Council. It gives us a solid foundation on which we can begin to look at extending our licence into accrediting higher education programmes and work-placed training schemes. I would like to take this opportunity to thank all our volunteer assessors and advisors for their continued support”.
